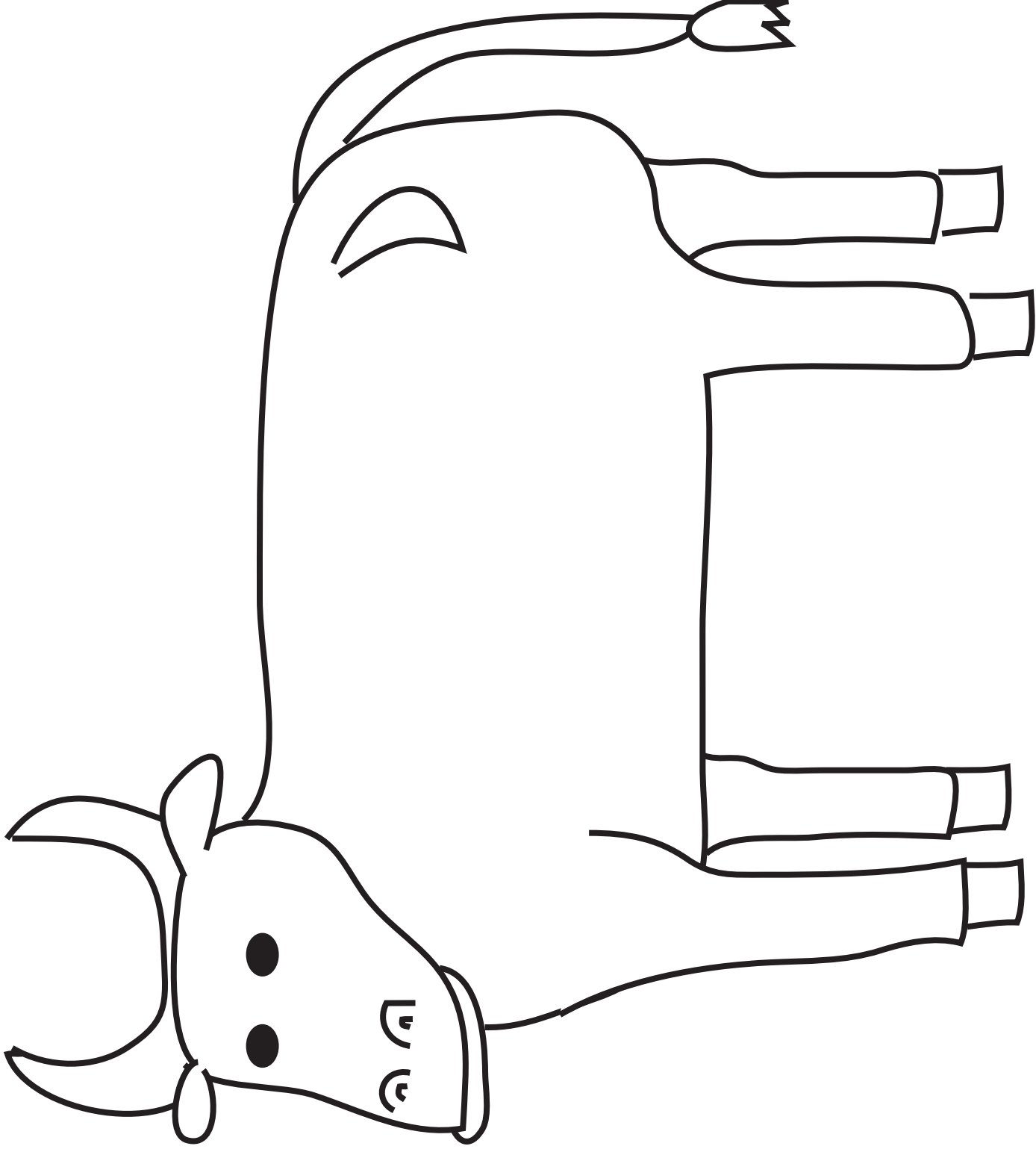
The first tent they would set up was God's special tent, the Tabernacle.
