





The Israelites did not trust God. They grumbled. But God was kind and gave them water from a rock. Exodus 17
















The Israelites grumbled (Exodus 16:1-4).	God gave them water (Exodus 17:5-7).

God saved the Israelites (Exodus 7-14).	God fed them (Exodus 16:13-18).












